His vision is for a church characterized by shared and collaborative leadership, embodying the biblical model of working together for the common good.

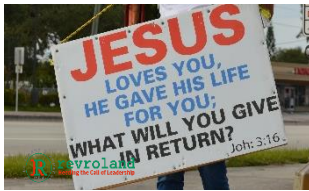
Commitment to Mission and Values

Recognize and strengthen the defining role of theological education in mission and evangelism by equipping leaders with a

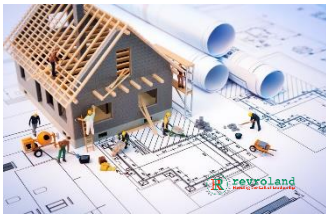


strong foundation in Christian doctrine and biblical affirmations, which is necessary to serve effectively.
